	'Free School Meals' refers to school meals available free of charge to individuals whose financial circumstances make them eligible.
First Generation Applicant	Question: During your time at secondary school, did any of your parents, step-parents, or guardians have an undergraduate degree (e.g. BA, BSc, etc.), or a postgraduate qualification such as a master's, a postgraduate diploma, a postgraduate certificate, or a doctorate?
Caring Responsibilities	Question: Do/did you have caring responsibilities for a family member or friend who could not manage without this help during secondary school and/or your undergraduate study?
	Caring responsibilities include providing unpaid care to a family member or friend who could not cope without your support, lasting for 3 months or more occupying more than 10 hours per week. This may be due to illness, disability, a mental health issue, or substance misuse.
Care or Foyer Background	Question: Have you ever lived in public care or as a looked-after child for a period of three months or more?

Mature Student	Question: Are you a mature undergraduate student? (That is, aged 21 or over at the start of your current undergraduate course.)
	Question: Would you be a mature postgraduate if you were to start postgraduate study in October 2025? (That is, aged 25 or over on 1 October 2025.)

State Support	Question: Are you in receipt of full state support for maintenance for your course of undergraduate study?
Refugee Status	Question: Are you, or have you been, recognised as a refugee, stateless person, or asylum seeker, or been granted humanitarian protection status by the UK government?
